Welcome

This roadmap is for bloggers who are creating content but haven't cracked monetization yet. Whether you're brand new or have been blogging for a while, this guide shows you the **6 clearest paths to income** — and how to pick the right one for where you are right now.

Who this guide is for

- Bloggers publishing content but earning little or nothing yet
- eCommerce content creators looking to diversify income
- Online entrepreneurs wanting to add passive revenue streams
- Anyone ready to treat their blog like a real business

How to use this guide: Read through all 6 methods first, then focus on the one that matches your current audience size, skills, and time available. You don't need all 6 — you need the right one, executed well.

The Monetization Ladder

Think of blog monetization as a ladder — each rung builds on the last. Start where you are. Climb as you grow.

◆ *You don't have to start at the bottom — but most bloggers see the fastest results by mastering one method before adding another.*

01 Affiliate Marketing

Affiliate marketing is the simplest way to start earning from your blog. You recommend products or services, and earn a commission every time someone buys through your unique link — no product creation required.

- Best networks: **Amazon Associates**, ShareASale, Impact, CJ Affiliate
- Highest-earning niches: tech, finance, beauty, home, online tools
- Place links in your top 3 most-read posts first — that's your fastest win
- Use comparison posts and 'best of' roundups for highest click-through rates
- Disclose affiliate relationships clearly — it builds trust and is legally required

Quick-start tip: Install a free link management plugin (like Pretty Links), sign up for Amazon Associates today, and add 3 affiliate links to your most-visited post before the week is out.

◆ *A blogger with just 500 monthly readers can earn \$200–\$500/month with well-placed affiliate links in high-intent posts.*

02 Display Ads

Display ads let you earn money passively — advertisers pay to show banners on your blog, and you get paid per 1,000 views (RPM). The more traffic you have, the more you earn.

- **Google AdSense:** Beginner-friendly, works from day one
- **Mediavine:** Premium rates, requires 50,000 sessions/month
- **Raptive (AdThrive):** Top tier, requires 100,000 pageviews/month
- Typical RPM ranges: AdSense \$2–8, Mediavine \$15–40, Raptive \$25–50
- Best ad placement: above the fold, within content, sticky sidebar
- Avoid overloading with ads — it hurts UX and SEO rankings

Quick-start tip: Start with Google AdSense while building traffic. Set a goal of 10k sessions/month to unlock better networks. Focus on SEO and Pinterest traffic for fastest growth.

◆ *At 10,000 monthly sessions with AdSense, expect \$50–\$120/month. The same traffic on Mediavine could earn \$300–\$600.*

03 Sponsored Posts

Brands pay bloggers to create content featuring their products or services. You don't need a huge audience — brands increasingly value niche, engaged audiences over raw follower counts.

- Create a simple media kit: your niche, audience stats, social reach, past work
- Pitch rate formula: \$100 per 10k monthly pageviews as a starting point
- Pitch brands directly via email or join networks: AspireIQ, Cooperatize, IZEA
- Package blog post + social shares for higher rates
- Always disclose sponsorships (#ad, #sponsored) — it's legally required
- Charge more for exclusivity, whitelisting rights, or usage in ads

Quick-start tip: Write 3 high-quality posts in your niche this month, then create a one-page media kit and pitch 5 brands that already advertise in your space.

◆ *Bloggers with 5,000–20,000 monthly readers regularly charge \$150–\$500 per sponsored post.*

04 Digital Products ■

Digital products are the highest-margin income stream for bloggers. You create it once and sell it unlimited times — no inventory, no shipping, near-zero overhead. This is the core of what 1clicksales.blog is built around.

- Best-selling types: planners, workbooks, templates, prompt PDFs, swipe files
- Where to sell: **Gumroad**, Selar, Payhip, your own WooCommerce store
- Price range: \$7–\$97 depending on depth and transformation provided
- Bundle products to increase average order value
- Use your blog content to validate what products your audience wants most
- Your email list is your most powerful sales channel for digital products

Quick-start tip: Pick your top blog post topic and turn it into a PDF workbook or template this weekend. List it on Gumroad for \$17–\$27 and promote it to your email list first.

◆ *A single \$27 digital planner sold 100 times = \$2,700 revenue. Sell it 500 times = \$13,500. The product stays the same.*

05 Email Marketing Funnels

Your email list is your most valuable business asset — you own it, no algorithm can take it away. A well-built funnel sells your products and affiliate offers automatically, 24/7.

- Offer a compelling lead magnet to grow your list fast (like this guide!)
- Welcome sequence: 5 emails over 7 days — value, value, value, offer, follow-up
- Segment subscribers by interest for higher open and click rates
- Tools: **Mailchimp** (free up to 500), ConvertKit, MailerLite
- Average email ROI: \$36 for every \$1 spent — highest of any channel
- One broadcast email per week minimum to stay top of mind

Quick-start tip: Set up your lead magnet opt-in today. Write a 5-email welcome sequence that ends with a soft offer for your best digital product.

◆ *A list of 1,000 engaged subscribers can generate \$500–\$2,000/month through a well-structured funnel — without a single paid ad.*

06 Courses & Coaching

Once you have an audience and proven expertise, packaging your knowledge into a course or coaching offer unlocks your highest income potential. This is where \$1,000+ months become \$10,000+ months.

- Start with a **mini-course** (\$47–\$197) before building a full course
- Platforms: Teachable, Thinkific, Gumroad, or even a Notion-based course
- Coaching (1:1 or group) can charge \$97–\$500/session with no course to build
- Validate first: sell via waitlist before you build anything
- Use your blog and email list to launch — no paid ads needed to start
- Testimonials are gold: offer free or discounted spots to first cohort

Quick-start tip: Survey your email list this week — ask what their #1 struggle is. The most common answer is your next course topic. Pre-sell before you build.

◆ *Many bloggers launch their first mini-course to a list of under 500 people and generate \$2,000–\$5,000 in their first week.*

Your 30-Day Action Plan

Pick one monetization method and run this plan. Don't try to do everything at once — focused action beats scattered effort every time.

Week	Focus	Key Actions
Week 1	Choose & Set Up	Pick your method • Set up your platform (Gumroad/AdSense/etc.) • Create your lead magnet opt-in form
Week 2	Create the Asset	Build your product / content / media kit • Write your welcome email sequence • Set up your automation
Week 3	Publish & Promote	Announce to your email list first • Share on social media • Add CTAs to your top 3 blog posts
Week 4	Review & Optimise	Check your numbers • Improve your weakest link • Plan your next income stream

Remember: Consistency beats perfection. Show up, publish, iterate. The bloggers who win aren't the most talented — they're the most consistent.
